RESOLUTION NO. _____ 3-23-21 LEG Adopt Police Reform Plan**Adopting the Cayuga County Police Reform & Reinvention Collaborative Plan pursuant to Executive Order No.: 203**

WHEREAS, on June 12, 2020, Governor Andrew Cuomo issued Executive Order No.: 203, charging every local governmental entity who employs a police presence to undertake a comprehensive review of current police deployments, strategies, policies, procedures and practices, and to develop a Comprehensive Police Reform Plan on or before April 1, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Cayuga County Sheriff's Office in partnership with the City of Auburn Police Department engaged in a collaborative, community-focused, public participation process wherein a number of community officials, facilitators and stakeholders, including Cayuga County elected officials, City of Auburn Elected Officials, Village Elected Officials, Auburn Police Department Leadership, County Sheriff's Office Leadership, Religious and Faith-Based Leaders, Social Justice Advocates, Education and Academic Sectors, Public Defenders Office, Services and Mental Health Providers, Victim Advocacy Leaders, Addiction and Peer Advocacy Leaders, Local Business Owners, Not-for-Profit Organizations, Migrant Population Advocates, Police Union Representatives, at Large Members, Byron Police Department Leadership, Weedsport Police Department Leadership, were brought together in strategic working groups, conducted public surveys, organized and held community forums in order to review current policies, practices and procedures and consider opportunities for reform; and

WHEREAS, the annexed Cayuga County Sheriff's Office Police Reform Plan is the culmination of the comprehensive community review outlined above that incorporates the ideas and needs of the citizens and stakeholders of Cayuga County in order to promote fair and just policing, enhance community relations and engagement, and to foster trust and mutual cooperation; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Cayuga County Legislature hereby adopts the annexed Cayuga County Sheriff's Office Police Reform Plan in compliance with NYS Governor Cuomo's Executive Order No.: 203.

Appointing Dale Currier as Director of the Emergency Services Office

WHEREAS, Mr. Currier had been previously appointed as Interim Director after the resignation of the Director and the Legislature would like to make the position permanent;

WHEREAS, the Legislative Steering Committee recommends that Dale Currier be appointed as the Cayuga County Director of Emergency Services; and

RESOLVED, that effective March 24th, 2021, Dale Currier be appointed as the Director of Emergency Services at an annual salary of \$72,000, and be it further

RESOLVED, that effective March 24, 2021, the appointee shall be entitled to three (3) weeks' vacation per year; and it is further

RESOLVED, that the appointment be made in accordance with Civil Services Rules and Regulations and policies of the County of Cayuga.

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
