IV. DIRECTOR'S REPORT – Governor released a proposed budget with items including mental health and substance abuse, largely focused on schools. Cayuga County recently trained various school administration on DBT skills as a universal approach. Cayuga County is applying for another SAMHSA Grant to aid with this implementation. The budget also touched on supportive housing. The DePaul project in Port Byron, which includes 39 units of mental health housing, should be finishing up this summer. Referral for the housing will all go through adult SPOA. CCCMHC has hired a social worker, with an anticipated start date of 3/6, and has an interview set up for another care manager that will allow the daytime Mobile Crisis program to begin. OMH is willing to fund the renovations to bring Liberty's adult respite up to code in order to bill for services. They are currently looking for a new property that is not a duplex to move forward with. The Diversion Grant is moving forward. Cayuga County and ACH have been meeting to improve the resources for substance abuse (MOUD, Narcan availability).


X. NEW BUSINESS – A By-laws and board responsibilities will be reviewed.
