There have been a total of 33 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Cayuga County.

Test Results Received –

As of today, we are awaiting the results of 21 tests that were performed on Cayuga County residents by the Cayuga County Health Department, physicians, healthcare facilities and licensed clinical laboratories.


