New Cases – 1 new case

- A female in her thirties, living inside the City of Auburn.

Contact tracing is complete.

Mandatory Quarantine/ Isolation

60 in Mandatory Quarantine

14 in Mandatory Isolation

Hospitalized patients

One hospitalized Cayuga County resident at this time.

Confirmed Cases – total year to date

There have been a total of 85 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Cayuga County.

Discharges- total year to date

There have been 70 individuals discharged from Mandatory Isolation.

Deaths

One death related to COVID-19 in our county.

Test Results Received –

Number of test results received since testing began in early March - 3,363 as of today.

- This information includes all testing of Cayuga County residents by physicians, healthcare facilities and licensed clinical laboratories.

Results pending – As of today, we are awaiting the results of 139 tests that were performed on Cayuga County residents by the Cayuga County Health Department, physicians, health care facilities and clinical laboratories.

Additional Information- Essential worker testing clinics held on May 9, May 11, May 12, May 14 and May 19 resulted in 596 individuals being test, all of which were negative. Results from our May 22 and May 26 clinics are still pending. All Cayuga County COVID19 positive cases identified to date are either essential workers, contacts of known positives or individuals who have had pre-admission testing.
