New cases

Tuesday, July 28, 2020 – one new case.

- A female in her eighties, living outside the City of Auburn.

Wednesday, July 29, 2020 – no new cases.

Thursday, July 30, 2020 – two new cases.

- A male in his thirties, living outside the City of Auburn.
- A female in her thirties, living inside the City of Auburn.

Friday, July 31, 2020 – no new cases.

Hospitalized Cases

Currently there is one Cayuga County resident hospitalized.

Confirmed Cases – total year to date

There have been a total of 141 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Cayuga County.

Discharges- total year to date

There have been 134 individuals discharged from Mandatory Isolation.

Deaths

There have been three Cayuga County deaths related to COVID-19.
