- Instructions**
1. Mark only with a blue or black pen.
 2. Mark the oval above or to the left of the name of your choice, like this ●
 3. To vote for a candidate whose name is not printed on the ballot, print the name clearly in the box labeled "Write-in" at the bottom of the column for office, staying within the box.
 4. To vote on a proposal that appears on the back, fill in the oval that corresponds to your "Yes" or "No" vote, like this ●
 5. Any mark or writing outside the voting spaces provided for voting may void this entire ballot.
 6. The number of choices is listed for each contest. Do not mark the ballot for more candidates than allowed. If you do, your vote in that contest will not count.
 7. If you make a mistake, or want to change your vote, ask a poll worker for a new ballot. If voting by absentee, call the Board of Elections at 315-253-1285 for instructions on how to obtain a new ballot.
 8. To be counted, absentee ballots returned by mail must be postmarked no later than the day of election and be received by the Cayuga County Board of Elections no later than 7 days after election day.
 9. After marking the absentee ballot, fold such ballot and enclose it in the envelope bearing the voter's statement, and seal the envelope.
 10. On the absentee ballot envelope, fill in properly the blanks in the statement and sign your name.
 11. Enclose the sealed envelope bearing the absentee statement in the envelope addressed to the Cayuga County Board of Elections and mail promptly.
