There have been a total of 503 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Cayuga County.

### **Discharges- total year to date**

There have been 405 individuals discharged from Mandatory Isolation.

### **Deaths**

There have been six Cayuga County deaths related to COVID-19.

### **Additional Information**

There was an error in the reporting of the confirmed cases-year to date total on the Monday November 2, 2020 press release. The number reported was 460, which should have been 459. We have corrected the error and the year to date total number is reflective of this correction.
