The Cayuga County Health Department is informing members of the public who visited the establishments listed below during the timeframes indicated may have been exposed to COVID19 and should monitor themselves for symptoms of COVID-19 for 14 days from the date of potential exposure.

**Wilcox General Store**, 1595 NY-34B, King Ferry, NY 13081 on Tuesday, November 3, 2020 from 8am – 2pm and Wednesday, November 4, 2020 from 8am – 2pm.

**Planet Fitness** 217 Grant Ave, Auburn, NY 13021 on Friday, November 6, 2020 from 12pm-1pm and 8pm – 9pm.

People with COVID-19 have had a wide range of symptoms reported – ranging from mild symptoms to severe illness. Symptoms may appear **2-14 days after exposure to the virus**. People with these symptoms may have COVID-19:

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

This list does not include all possible symptoms. If symptoms do develop, stay home, and call your doctor for further guidance. If you are elderly, have underlying medical conditions, or are immunocompromised, call your doctor early even if your illness is mild. In an emergency, call 911.

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
