Cayuga County COVID-19 Situational Update as of 4:15pm

New Cases

Sunday, January 4, 2021 – one hundred three new cases admitted plus five residential cases at a local correctional facilities

Three Cayuga County residents who were hospitalized and had tested positive for COVID-19, have passed away. The decedents, a female in her 90's, a male in his 80's and a male in his 70's had been hospitalized at the time of their deaths. Out of respect for the privacy of the deceased and their families, we will not be releasing further information.

Confirmed Cases – total since March 18, 2020
