New Cases

Thursday, January 7, 2021 – 147 new cases admitted plus 11 residential cases at local correctional facilities

Five Cayuga County nursing home residents, a female in her 60's, a female in her 80's, a male in his 80's, a male in his 90' and a male in his 100's, had tested positive for COVID-19 and have passed away. Out of respect for the privacy of the deceased and their families, we will not be releasing further information.

Cases Awaiting Admission

Active Cases in Mandatory Quarantine/ Isolation

8,054 Mandatory Quarantine
1,095 in Mandatory Isolation

Confirmed Cases – total since March 18, 2020

There have been 2,511 individuals discharged from Mandatory Isolation.
