New Cases

Friday, March 12, 2021 – six new cases admitted

There have been 5,395 cases of COVID-19 in Cayuga County.

Additional Information

Individuals age 60 and older are now eligible to receive the COVID19 vaccine. NYS has expanded eligibility further effective March 17, 2021. These eligible individuals will include:

- public-facing government and public employees
- not-for-profit workers who provide public-facing services to New Yorkers in need
- Essential in-person public-facing building service workers

If you are eligible, please work through your employer to contact the Department or join the eligible lists being maintained by your Village, Town or the City in Cayuga County.

The availability of the vaccine is not limited to just the health department. Individuals are encouraged to work with local pharmacies, federally qualified health centers and the NYS mass vaccination sites to get an appointment.

To make the most efficient use of all our vaccines, we do ask that if you are on a number of wait lists or if you have appointments scheduled at multiple locations, that once you receive the vaccine, you remove your name or cancel other appointments that you will not need.
