Cayuga County Health Department is holding two **walk-in** COVID-19 vaccination clinics next week. The first will be held on Thursday, July 8th at the Victory Fire Department, 12009 State Rt. 38, Cato, NY from 1pm-2:30pm. The second clinic will be Friday, July 9th at the Southern Cayuga Jr. Sr. High School, 2384 Rt. 34B, Aurora, NY from 12pm-1:30pm.

We will be offering Moderna and Johnson & Johnson vaccines for adults 18 years of age and older and the Pfizer vaccine for individuals 12 years of age and older. A parent or guardian must accompany anyone under 18 years of age.
