### **New Cases**

### **Additional Information**

A majority of the positive COVID-19 cases are those who are not fully vaccinated. Last week, from July 16, 2021- July 22, 2021 there were 16 new COVID-19 cases admitted. Of those cases, 13 were not vaccinated. We encourage eligible people who have not yet received their COVID-19 vaccine to do so now.

We will be holding a **walk-in** COVID-19 vaccination clinic on Tuesday, July 27, 2021 at the Scipio Center Fire House located at 3550 State Route 34, Scipio Center from 3:30pm-4:30pm. We will be offering Moderna, Pfizer and Johnson & Johnson vaccines. Children 12 years of age and older are eligible for the Pfizer vaccine and a parent or guardian must accompany anyone under 18 years of age at this clinic.
