### **New Cases**

Wednesday, September 8, 2021 – 47 positive cases completed

- 34 unvaccinated, 13 vaccinated

### **Active Cases in Mandatory Isolation**

223 Mandatory Isolation

### **Confirmed Cases – total since March 18, 2020**

There have been 7,322 cases of COVID-19 in Cayuga County.

A walk-in vaccination clinic will be held Tuesday, September 14 at Moravia Fire Department, 38 Keeler St, Moravia, NY 13118 from 3pm-4pm. Both Pfizer and Moderna vaccines will be available.

A walk-in vaccination clinic will be held Wednesday, September 15 at Scipio Fire Department, 3550 NY-34, Scipio Center, NY 13147 from 3pm-4pm. Both Pfizer and Johnson & Johnson vaccines will be available.

Children 12 years of age and older are eligible for the Pfizer vaccine and a parent or guardian must accompany anyone under 18 years of age at this clinic.
