Three Cayuga County residents have tested positive for COVID-19 and have passed away; a female in her thirties, a male in his eighties and a male in his hundreds. Out of respect for the privacy of the deceased and their families, we will not be releasing further information.

There have been 101 total Cayuga County deaths related to COVID-19.

Upcoming Clinics

The Cayuga County Health Department will be hosting a walk-in COVID-19 vaccine clinic at CIMVAC on West Main Street, Cato, on Tuesday, September 28th from 2pm – 3pm. We will be offering Pfizer and Moderna. Children 12 years of age and older are eligible for the Pfizer vaccine and a parent or guardian must accompany anyone under 18 years of age at this clinic.

The Cayuga County Health Department will be hosting a COVID-19 vaccination clinic on Saturday, October 2, 2021. REGISTRATION WILL BE REQUIRED. To register for an appointment visit: www.cayugacounty.us/health

The clinic will be held at the Fingerlakes mall from 10am – 12pm. Both first and second doses will be available. All three COVID-19 vaccines will be offered. Moderna and Johnson & Johnson are approved for those who are 18 years of age and older.

Children 12 years of age and older are eligible for the Pfizer vaccine and a parent or guardian must accompany anyone under 18 years of age at this clinic.
