Cayuga County Pediatric Pfizer Clinic

This week and next, the Cayuga County Health Department is offering school-based clinics for children 5-11 years of age. In an effort to accommodate families, we have scheduled a community-based clinic this Saturday, November 20th from 10am – 12pm. This will be a Pfizer vaccination clinic ONLY for 5 – 11 year-old individuals. They must be accompanied by a parent / guardian.

REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED – please visit www.cayugacounty.us/health to schedule an appointment. Please bring your child's insurance card. This clinic will be held at the Fingerlakes Mall located at 1579 Clark St., Auburn at the former Joann Fabric store location. Please enter through the front of the mall to the left of the Bass Pro Shops.

The timing of the first dose clinics and second dose clinics will provide these children with full immunity by the December holidays and winter break. If you and your family plan to gather or travel during the holidays, vaccination provides protection for your family and loved ones this holiday season.

Fully vaccinated individuals are exempt from quarantine when they have been exposed to a positive case as long as they remain symptom-free. This means school-aged children will not have to quarantine and miss school, if they are fully vaccinated and symptom-free!

The pediatric Pfizer vaccine is also available through some local health care provider offices. Please contact your child's health care provider if you have questions or prefer to have your child vaccinated at their office. In addition, some local pharmacies are offering the vaccine.
