Cayuga County COVID-19 Situational Update as of 4:15pm

New Cases:

Thursday, January 13, 2022 – 382 completed

- 173 unvaccinated, 209 vaccinated

Active Cases in Mandatory Isolation: 635 in Mandatory Isolation

Confirmed Cases – total since March 18, 2020:

There have been 14,312 cases of COVID-19 reported in Cayuga County.

Total hospitalized cases: 20 Cayuga County residents (10 of which are unvaccinated)

COVID-19 hospitalization reports received today from Crouse Hospital, Upstate University Hospital, St. Joseph's Health, and Auburn Community Hospital.

A Cayuga County resident, a female in her seventies, has tested positive for COVID-19 and has passed away. Out of respect for the privacy of the deceased and her family, we will not be releasing any further information.
