New Cases:

Friday, January 14, 2022 – 387 completed

- 210 unvaccinated, 177 vaccinated

Saturday, January 15, 2022 – 276 completed

- 118 unvaccinated, 158 vaccinated

Sunday, January 16, 2022 – 99 completed

- 37 unvaccinated, 62 vaccinated

Monday, January 17, 2022 – Martin Luther King Jr. Day, observed holiday for staff, no cases completed

Active Cases in Mandatory Isolation: 580 in Mandatory Isolation

Confirmed Cases – total since March 18, 2020:

There have been 15,074 cases of COVID-19 reported in Cayuga County.

Total hospitalized cases: 29 Cayuga County residents (15 of which are unvaccinated)
