



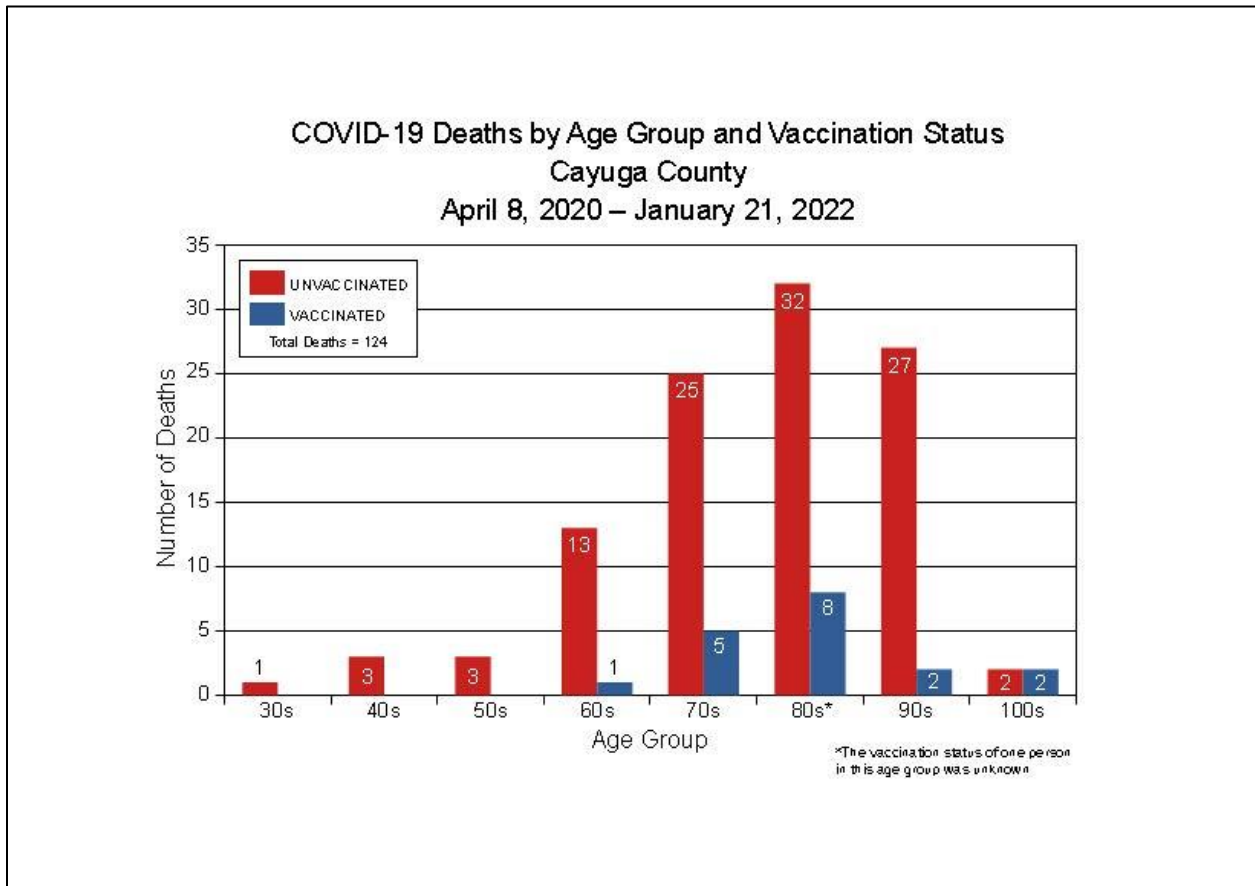

### 2021 Cayuga County COVID-19 Summary

Since the beginning of the pandemic (March 2020), there have been 124 reported COVID-19-related deaths in Cayuga County. In 2021, there were a total of 89 reported deaths due to COVID-19. Below is a graphic representing the age and vaccination status of those who have died due to COVID-19.



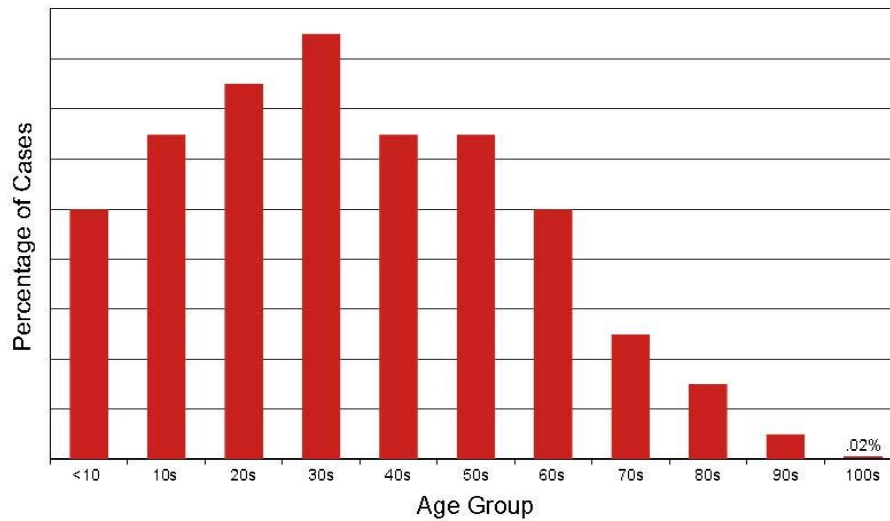

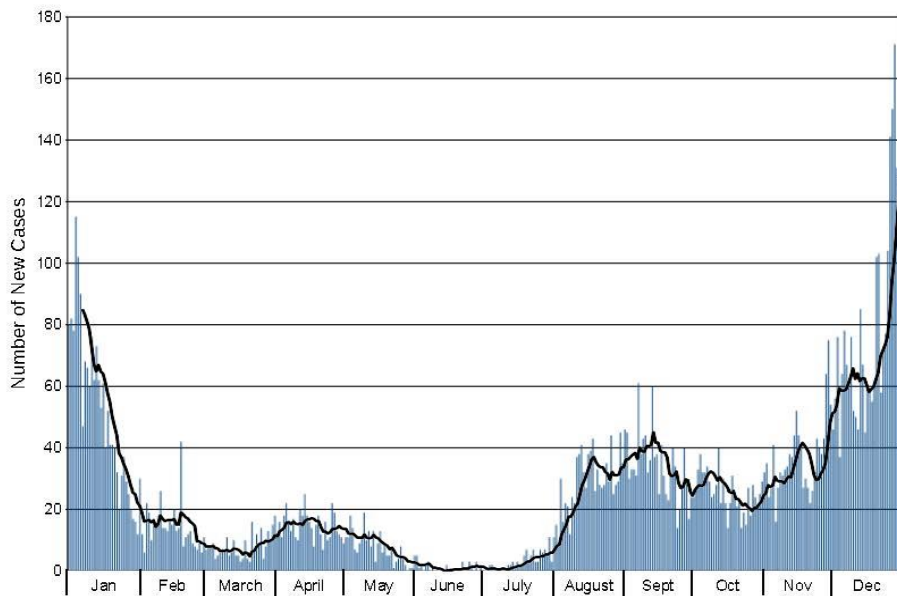
