Deaths:

A Cayuga County resident – a female in her sixties – has tested positive for COVID-19 and has passed away. Out of respect for the privacy of the deceased and her family, we will not be releasing any further information.

There have been 150 total reported Cayuga County deaths related to COVID-19.

Additional Information:

As Cayuga County continues to see a downward trend in the positivity rate of COVID-19 cases, we will be changing the format of our daily update.
