Steering Committee Summary

Time Commitment

- 1. The steering committee will meet approximately 13 times over 16 months, typically once per month.
- 2. The purpose of the steering committee is to advise and provide guidance as the plan is developed.
- 3. Members will be asked to help notify their neighbors of opportunities to participate in this process, such as the public meetings and focus groups.
- 4. The Cayuga County Planning & Economic Development Department may reach out to committee members occasionally via email, phone, or letter to get specific feedback or guidance in a member's area of expertise.

What does a Farmland Protection Plan do?

- Identifies opportunities to expand agricultural businesses, encourage agricultural entrepreneurs, and strengthen the local economy.
- Establishes the foundation for a purchase of development rights (PDR) program to permanently preserve farms.
- Reviews local regulatory controls to determine how they might aid in maintaining agriculture.
- Enables protection of prime soils by establishing an inventory of the Town's agricultural resources and soil characteristics.
- Provides technical assistance to address farmers' nutrient, resource, and farm management challenges.
- Establishes a process for dealing with farmer-neighbor conflicts so that nuisance disputes can be resolved quickly and locally.
- Increases awareness and appreciation for agriculture throughout the community.
