Cross Connection Control Plan Design Submittal

A Backflow Prevention Installation Design Proposal must include the following

- *Application for Approval of Backflow Prevention Devices* with Water Supplier signature and \$100 review fee.
- Site Plan showing water line(s) to building and with general location map inset.
- Plumbing Floor Plan with dimensions surrounding device.
- Vertical Cross-Section with dimensions surrounding device.
- Manufacturer's specification sheets for device and associated equipment. The University of Southern California Foundation for Cross-Connection Control and Hydraulic Research (FCCCHR) Certification must be shown on the manufacturer's specification sheet.
- Applicable information from the *Checklist for Backflow Prevention Device Installation* must be included.

Steps for Approving an Installation

- Submit 4 copies of the engineering design proposal to the Cayuga County Health Department at the address below.
- Once the plan is approved, 2 sets of stamped plans will be returned to the design professional, one set will be sent to the water supplier, and one will be retained by the Health Department.
- After the device is installed, a New York State certified tester must test the device and the design professional must verify that the device was installed as per the approved plans.
