As part of his 2018 State of the State announcements, Governor Cuomo directed the state's Water Quality Rapid Response Team to convene four regional Harmful Algal Blooms summits. The Central New York Harmful Algal Blooms (HABs) Regional Summit was held on March 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> in Syracuse and concentrated on Cayuga, Owasco and Skaneateles Lakes. This summit also included an evening session on March 6<sup>th</sup> that was open to the public where background information about harmful algal blooms was provided; as well as talks by experts, a panel discussion and an opportunity for local residents to share recommendations and ideas.
