PROPOSAL NUMBER THREE, AN AMENDMENT

The proposed amendment will create a land account with up to 250 acres of forest preserve land

preserve land to address specific public health and safety concerns; as a substitute for the land
removed from the forest preserve, another 250 acres of land, will be added to the forest preserve,
subject to legislative approval. The proposed amendment also will allow bicycle trails and certain
public utility lines to be located within the width of specified highways that cross the forest preserve
while minimizing removal of trees and vegetation. Shall the proposed amendment be approved?
