

MINUTES
CAYUGA COUNTY PLANNING BOARD
June 2, 2004

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm at the Historic School House in the Town of Cato. Peg Sweetman gave a tour of the building and grounds and gave background and historical information on the building.

After visiting the Historic School House members traveled north to the new Ira Town Building in the Village of Cato. Dorothy Southard gave a tour of their new facility. The remainder of the planning board meeting took place in the Town of Ira Town Building.

The minutes from April 2004 were approved.

Local Status Reports:

Village of Cato: Civic Heritage is working with NYS DEC to determine location of 100 yr floodplain, on their site in Cato, in order to design the septic system. NYS DEC will also be assisting them with their SPDES permit.

Town of Fleming: No status on church. Fred Farrell has been attending meeting on Hotel at Emerson Park, the County is still moving forward with the RFP. There is concern that they will lose too much of the park and lakeview and it won't come back.

Village of Cayuga: RFP for the joint Cayuga Aurelius comprehensive plan has been released and hope at the 1st Tuesday in July to review applications.

Town of Aurelius (presented by Village of Cayuga representative): Bass Pro Opens to the public on July 10th.

Town of Mentz: Currently working on the Comprehensive Plan. Has developed a good board and they are starting work. They are going to work with the Village of Port Byron on the project.

Town of Cato: Still working on a Comprehensive Plan.

Town of Victory: Still working on a Comprehensive Plan.

Village of Union Springs: Contracted with Cayuga County Planning Department to provide planning services for their Comprehensive Plan.

Port Byron: Green Street bridge reconstruction is in its final stages and hopes to open this year.
