Seasonal Flu Clinics

The Cayuga County Health Department would like to inform the public that the Seasonal Flu clinics will be held earlier this year. The Health Department plans on holding two public clinics for Seasonal Flu vaccine, additional flu clinics may be scheduled based on vaccine supply.

The 2009 Seasonal Flu clinics schedule:

**Friday September 18, 9-11 a.m., St Patrick's Church,
Mechanic St., Cato**

**Friday October 2, 9-11a.m., BOCES Campus,
1879 West Genesee St Rd, Auburn**

Clinics are for adults ages 18 and older.

No appointment is necessary, and there is no charge for people with Medicare Part B who bring their card to the clinic. The department will bill Medicare Part B for the vaccine charges.

Those not covered under Medicare Part B will be charged \$30 for a flu shot. Pneumococcal vaccines will be available for people with a doctor's prescription. The cost of the pneumococcal vaccine is \$45.

As we prepare for the flu season we are also preparing for H1N1 (Swine) flu to spike again. The Cayuga County Health Department plans on hosting H1N1 (Swine) flu clinics once the vaccine is received. Further information regarding availability of and eligibility for H1N1 (Swine) flu vaccine will be shared as it becomes available.
