Cayuga County Health Department to Hold Flu Clinics

Auburn, NY: The Cayuga County Health Department will hold flu clinics this year in Auburn, Aurelius, Cato and Moravia. Clinics are for adults ages 18 and older.

No appointment is necessary, and there is no charge for people with Medicare Part B who bring their card to the clinic. The department will bill Medicare Part B for the vaccine charges.

Those not covered under Medicare Part B will be charged \$30 for a flu shot. Pneumococcal vaccines will be available for people with a doctor's prescription. The cost of the pneumococcal vaccine is \$45.

The public flu clinic schedule is posted on the county health department Web site, www.cayugacounty.us/hhs/doh. Callers can access a recording of the scheduled health department flu clinics for each week by calling (315) 253-1157.
