The Emergency Management office has hired a Deputy Director, Harry Sherman. He started in the office on March 2, 2020.

Bi-weekly Ontario Lake calls with NYS have been productive in assessing stockpile inventories and continuous communications are happening with Town of Sterling Supervisor and Village of Fair Haven Mayor.

Communications are happening between EMO and CC Dept. of Health regarding COVID-19 and being disseminated to our first responders

• **Brian Schenck (Sheriff) –**

- Members of the Cayuga County Sheriff's Employee Association (Custody Union), the Sheriff, and the Legislature reached a proposed bargaining agreement for a term of four years. The proposed agreement was ratified by the union on Tuesday March 3rd.
- The Sheriff did meet with administrative staff of the Part Byron High School to continue discussing the possibility of contracting with the school to provide a Student Resource Officer utilizing a Special Patrol position within the Sheriff's Office. Talks are continuing and appear to be moving in a positive direction. HR and the Sheriff are also working together to finalize a draft job description to present to the legislature next month.
- The Sheriff and Administrative Staff continue to look at options to update our 556 page policy and procedure manual. With continually changing laws, mandates, and best practices, it is crucial and challenging to maintain current policy and procedure. An electronic version would improve efficiency. Working with an outside provider to maintain our policy would also improve our efficiency but more importantly, limit our liability as our policy would continually be updated

utilizing the most recent best practices and immediately incorporating changes to the law. There would be additional cost to move in this direction; however, the cost to utilize staff internally is much greater.

- At the time of this report we are housing 125 inmates in our jail with 42 of those inmates being Federal board ins. We are maintaining 6 open (budgeted) staff positions in the jail; however, we may need to consider filling 2 or 3 of those positions in the coming months with challenges we are facing with the new Centralized Arraignment Court and volume – see below.
- Our new Centralized Arraignment Part (CAP) Court and pre arraignment detention has been in place and operational at the jail since February 11<sup>th</sup>. In less than a month, and at the time of this report, we have processed 36 people through the court with detainees being housed from the New York State Police, Auburn Police Department, and our Sheriff's Office. This is a much higher number than we anticipated and we will need to monitor this for the next month or two to determine the future impact on our staffing levels at the jail.

**AUTHORIZATION TO CREATE A FULL-TIME ASSISTANT DISTRICT ATTORNEY POSITION IN THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE AND SETTING THE SALARY (2/3)**

BY: Hon. Andy Dennison, Chairman, Judicial & Public Safety; and  
Hon. Christopher Petrus, Chairman, Ways and Means

WHEREAS, the recently enacted New York State Criminal Justice "Reforms" (to Bail, Discovery, and Speedy Trial) will take effect on January 1, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the new statutes will create new burdens significantly increasing the workloads and shortening the timelines impacting the functions of the District Attorney's Office; and

WHEREAS, the prosecution shall be required to perform complete their discovery obligations as soon as practicable, but not later than fifteen calendar days after the defendant's arraignment, and the new obligation is to provide absolutely everything (akin to what was required prior to trial, months after any arrests); and

WHEREAS, the District Attorney has demonstrated a need for additional legal assistance in handling the increased workload in accordance with the new statutes to avoid dismissals and other unacceptable ramifications and the State has failed to fund this new mandate; and

WHEREAS, the Cayuga County Legislature is desirous of providing the District Attorney with adequate resources to prosecute crime in Cayuga County and protect its Citizens; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the District Attorney is authorized to create and fill the full-time position of Assistant District Attorney at an annual salary of \$63,900.00, and that said position be placed in Part IV of the Cayuga County Compensation Plan; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the District Attorney's Full-Time Salary Budget Line (A11651) and related fringe benefit accounts be increased by an additional amount of \$58,000 (8/12<sup>th</sup> of the annual salary and fringe) with said funding taken from the unrestricted, unappropriated fund balance; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the foregoing be accomplished in accordance with Cayuga County Civil Service Rules and Regulations and the policies of the County of Cayuga; and be it further
