

STANDARD WORK DAY AND REPORTING RESOLUTION FOR ELECTED AND APPOINTED OFFICIALS

WHEREAS, New York State adopted a new regulation 315.4 for additional reporting requirements for elected or appointed officials that more clearly defines the process for reporting time worked for those officials who are members of the New York State Retirement System elected or appointed on or after August 12, 2009; and

WHEREAS, a three month record of work activities was submitted to the Clerk of the Legislature by those officials that do not maintain a daily record of actual time worked; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, on recommendation of the Government Operations Committee, that the Cayuga County Legislature hereby establishes the following as standard work days for elected officials and appointed officials and will report the following days worked to the New York State and Local Employees' Retirement System based on the record of activities maintained and submitted by these officials to the Clerk of this body: **see attached**; and it is further

RESOLVED, that the redacted copy of the resolution which does not show the employees last four digits of their social security number or registration number shall be posted on the Cayuga County website for a minimum of 30 days and that a certified copy of the resolution and affidavit of posting be filed with the Office of the State Comptroller within 45 days of adoption.
