Radio Policy

-Ben advised that a meeting w/fire departments would be forthcoming to discuss issues such as single dispatch

-A discussion was raised regarding whether secondary departments should be automatically re-activated by dispatch after 5 minutes even if the primary department has acknowledged. Per radio policy, any re-activations go through the department once call has been acknowledged. Dispatch may ask if departments need to be re-toned, but it shouldn't be done automatically

New Business

-APD/NYSP both stated status check policy working well

-Sgt. Lester was asked if NYSP units were experiencing any radio spottiness in south part of county. He stated no issues had been reported to him.

-Captain Deyneka requested that units doing Saturday inspections not be placed straight into "arrived status" as it affects reporting. Ben stated he would advise staff.

-Chief Morabito requested that dispatch go back to acknowledging TLC when they call on radio. Previously, the intent was for TLC to announce being enroute/arrived for informational purposes only.

-Jason requested that important correspondences (such as the one regarding radio issues) also be sent to the PROC committee. Ben said that this would be done.
