**New Cases** – 1 new cases

- A female in her 40's, living inside the City.

Contact tracing is currently underway

### **Mandatory Quarantine/ Isolation**

18 in Mandatory Quarantine

12 in Mandatory Isolation

### **Hospitalized patients**

No hospitalized Cayuga County residents at this time.

### **Confirmed Cases – total year to date**

There have been a total of 65 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Cayuga County.

### **Discharges- total year to date**

There have been 52 individuals discharged from Mandatory Isolation.

### **Deaths**

One death related to COVID-19 in our county.

### **Test Results Received –**

Number of test results received since testing began in early March – 1,686 as of today.

- This information includes all testing of Cayuga County residents by physicians, healthcare facilities and licensed clinical laboratories.

### **Results pending –**

As of today, we are awaiting the results of 271 tests that were performed on Cayuga County residents by the Cayuga County Health Department, physicians, health care facilities and licensed clinical laboratories.
