There have been a total of 113 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Cayuga County.

Discharges- total year to date

There have been 105 individuals discharged from Mandatory Isolation.

Deaths

There have been two Cayuga County deaths related to COVID-19.

Additional Information

We remind the public that face coverings are required to be worn indoors and outdoors while in public when social distancing cannot be maintained as per the New York State Governor's Executive Order 202.17.

Cayuga County has entered Phase 4 today, Friday, June 26, 2020. All non-essential gatherings will increase from 25 to 50 people. The one exception to this is high school graduation ceremonies.
