## **Clinic Scheduled for COVID-19 Testing**

A clinic is scheduled for individuals to be tested for COVID-19. This is the nasopharyngeal viral testing swab, not the antibody test. The Cayuga County Health Department has been following New York State Department of Health (NYSDOH) criteria for testing.

The Cayuga County Health Department will be offering a drive-thru COVID-19 clinic on:

- **Tuesday, July 28, 2020 from 8:00am –10:00am.**
- The drive-thru clinic is **by appointment only.**
- Individuals need to make their own appointment and arrive on time.
  - **Employers should not make appointments for their employees, as we need to collect specific, individualized information on each person.**

These drive-thru clinics continue to offer testing for those who are experiencing symptoms or were in direct contact with a confirmed case. Priority for testing continues for those essential workers and employees working under any of the four phases of NY re-opening. This clinic is also open to household members of these workers and employees, including children ages two and older.

Our clinic on Tuesday, July 28, 2020 will be our last public drive thru clinic for the foreseeable future. Should the need arise for us to resume our drive thru clinics, we will do so.

If someone is in need of testing, they can check with their healthcare provider or go to a local urgent care center for testing.
