Cayuga County COVID-19 Super Spreader Event #3

Over the Halloween weekend, many people gathered socially. As we are about three weeks out from Halloween the Cayuga County Health Department is still managing cases associated with those gatherings.

The attached graphic demonstrates just how contagious the COVID-19 virus is and the control that individuals have in minimizing the spread of the virus by not interacting with people outside of their households. Additionally, we continue to reinforce the importance of wearing face a cover and limiting the duration of time spent with people not in your household.

This gathering resulted in 10 positive cases with 34 individuals being placed into quarantine. There were three Cayuga County schools impacted from this gathering. This particular gathering demonstrates how one social gathering can have significant impact on our community, including our schools.
