Cayuga County COVID-19 Situational Update as of 4:30pm

New Cases

Monday, December 28, 2020 – eighty-seven new cases admitted plus twenty-two residential cases at local correctional facilities

Three Cayuga County residents who were hospitalized and had tested positive for COVID-19, have passed away. The decedents, a male in his 80's and two females in their 80's had been hospitalized with underlying medical conditions which may have contributed to their deaths.

Three Cayuga County nursing home residents, two males in their 80's and a male in his 70's who had tested positive for COVID-19 have also passed away. It was reported to us today that a Cayuga County male in his 70's, who was hospitalized out of county and had tested positive for COVID-19, passed away November 18, 2020. Out of respect for the privacy of the deceased and their families, we will not be releasing further information.
