## **No-Cost COVID-19 Testing Clinic for Cayuga County Residents**

The Cayuga County Health Department in partnership with Auburn Community Hospital would like to inform the public of an upcoming no-cost COVID-19 drive-thru testing clinic.

**Sunday, January 3, 2020** – this drive thru clinic is for individuals **who are experiencing symptoms**. This clinic will be held from 9am – 12:30pm at the Cayuga-Onondaga BOCES campus located at 1879 W. Genesee St. Rd. in Auburn.

**You must have an appointment in order to participate in this clinic.** Registration ability stops in advance of the clinic and/or when fully booked.

Recently, we have had individuals double booking and then no showing to one of their appointments. When people do not show up for an appointment, it prevents others who could not register from receiving a test.

We ask that you only make an appointment for this clinic, if you plan to keep it.

### How to make an appointment –

- Click on the button titled, COVID-19 Clinics.
- When making your appointment we need your:
  - **Legal name (not nicknames)**
  - Home address
  - **Email address (you must provide an email address when making an appointment in order to receive results through the portal)**
  - Insurance information
  - If the policy is under another person's name, we need his or her legal name and date of birth.
  - If you do not have insurance, write No Insurance in each required field.
  - Phone number that we can use to call with results.
    - **Only those who test positive will receive a phone call from the health department to be placed into Mandatory Isolation.**

Instructions on a portal system to access your results will be provided to you after you are tested.
