## **Cayuga County COVID-19 Situational Update as of 4:30pm**

### **New Cases**

Monday, January 4, 2021 – one hundred twenty-four cases admitted plus sixteen residential cases at a local correctional facilities

Six Cayuga County nursing home residents, two females in their 90's, three males in their 70's and a female in her 70's had tested positive for COVID-19 and have passed away. Out of respect for the privacy of the deceased and their families, we will not be releasing further information.

### **Cases Awaiting Admission**

- January 5, 2021 – 132 cases at 8 a.m.

### **Active Cases in Mandatory Quarantine/ Isolation**

6,788 Mandatory Quarantine  
1,011 in Mandatory Isolation

### **Confirmed Cases – total since March 18, 2020**

There have been 3,261 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Cayuga County.

### **Discharges - total since March 18, 2020**

There have been 2,217 individuals discharged from Mandatory Isolation.

### **Hospitalizations**

There are 40 COVID-19 related hospitalized cases at Auburn Community Hospital.

### **Deaths**

There have been 33 Cayuga County deaths related to COVID-19.
