## **Cayuga County COVID-19 Situational Update as of 2:15pm**

### **New Cases**

Tuesday, January 19, 2021 – one hundred-nine new cases admitted, plus eight residential cases at local correctional facilities

Two Cayuga County nursing home residents, both females in their 80's had tested positive for COVID-19 and have passed away. Out of respect for the privacy of the deceased and their families, we will not be releasing further information.

### **Cases Awaiting Admission**

- January 20, 2021 – 87 cases at 8 a.m.

### **Active Cases in Mandatory Quarantine/ Isolation**

2,406 in Mandatory Quarantine

440 in Mandatory Isolation

### **Confirmed Cases – total since March 18, 2020**

There have been 4,428 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Cayuga County.

### **Discharges - total since March 18, 2020**

There have been 3,916 individuals discharged from Mandatory Isolation.

### **Hospitalizations**

There are 41 COVID-19 related hospitalized cases at Auburn Community Hospital.

### **Deaths**

There have been 72 Cayuga County deaths related to COVID-19.

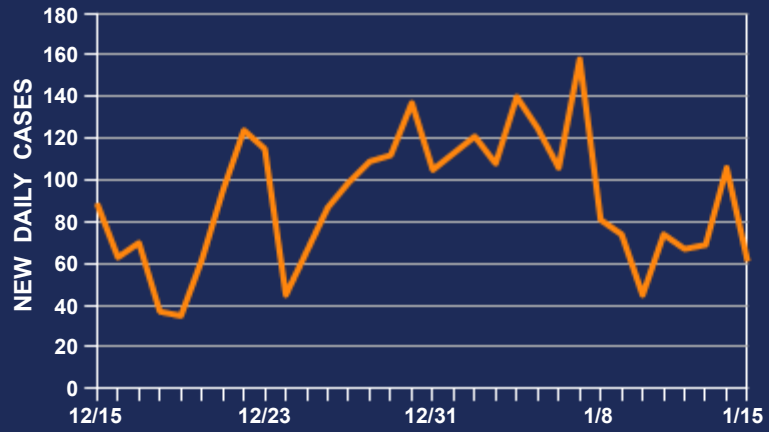

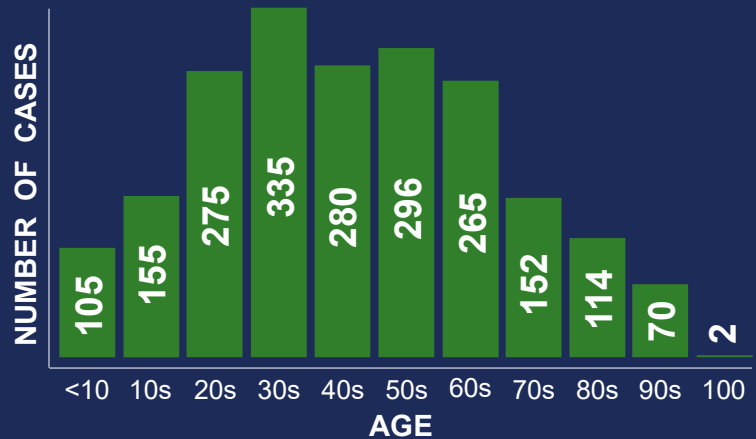
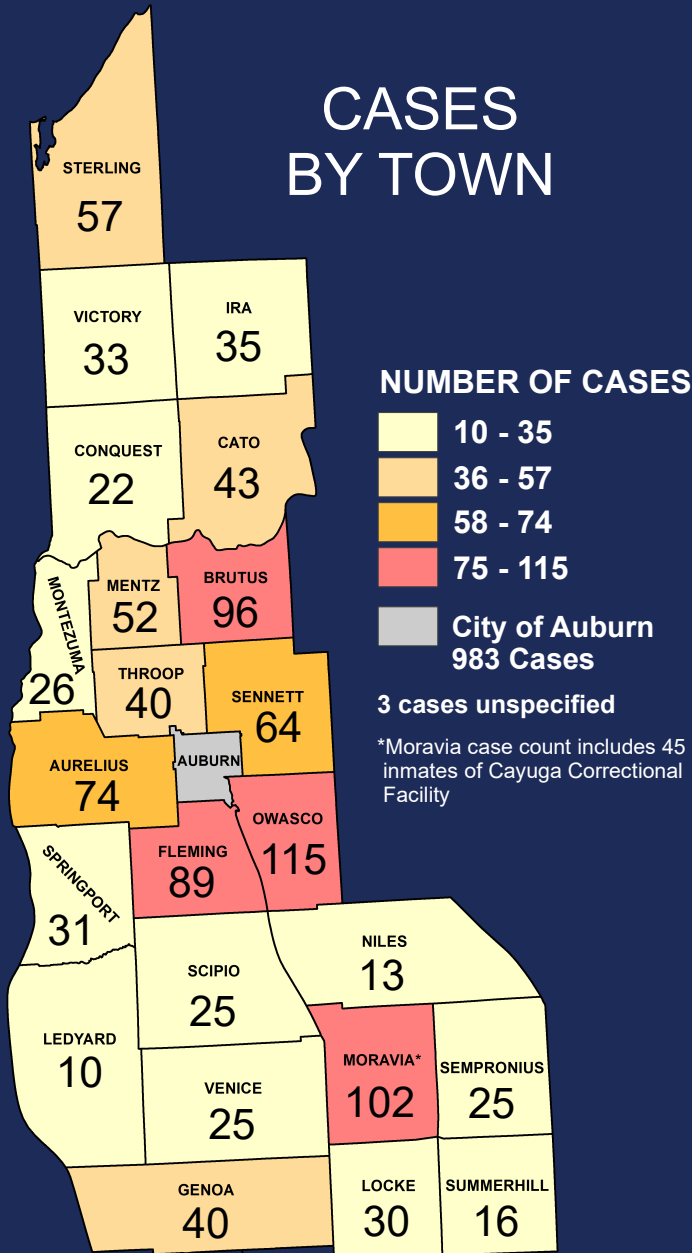
