## **Cayuga County COVID-19 Situational Update as of 2:00pm**

### **New Cases**

Sunday, January 24, 2021 – twenty-three new cases admitted, plus two residential cases at local correctional facilities

One Cayuga County nursing home resident, a female in her 90's had tested positive for COVID-19 and has passed away. Out of respect for the privacy of the deceased and their families, we will not be releasing further information.

### **Cases Awaiting Admission**

- January 25, 2021 –50 cases at 8 a.m.

### **Active Cases in Mandatory Quarantine/ Isolation**

1,552 in Mandatory Quarantine  
330 in Mandatory Isolation

### **Confirmed Cases – total since March 18, 2020**

There have been 4,695 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Cayuga County.

### **Discharges - total since March 18, 2020**

There have been 4,289 individuals discharged from Mandatory Isolation.

### **Hospitalizations**

There are 27 COVID-19 related hospitalized cases at Auburn Community Hospital.

### **Deaths**

There have been 76 Cayuga County deaths related to COVID-19.

### **Additional Information**

Per New York State's mandate, local health departments are restricted to serving a sub group of the 1B population for vaccine administration, which excludes individuals 65 and older at this time. Pharmacies and physician network or practice groups are responsible for vaccinating the 65 and older population. We will share more information as it becomes available.
