New Cases

Tuesday, January 26, 2021 – thirty-three new cases admitted, one residential case at a local correctional facility

Two Cayuga County nursing home residents, a male in his 70's and a female in her 90's had tested positive for COVID-19 and have passed away. Out of respect for the privacy of the deceased and their families, we will not be releasing further information.
