Deaths

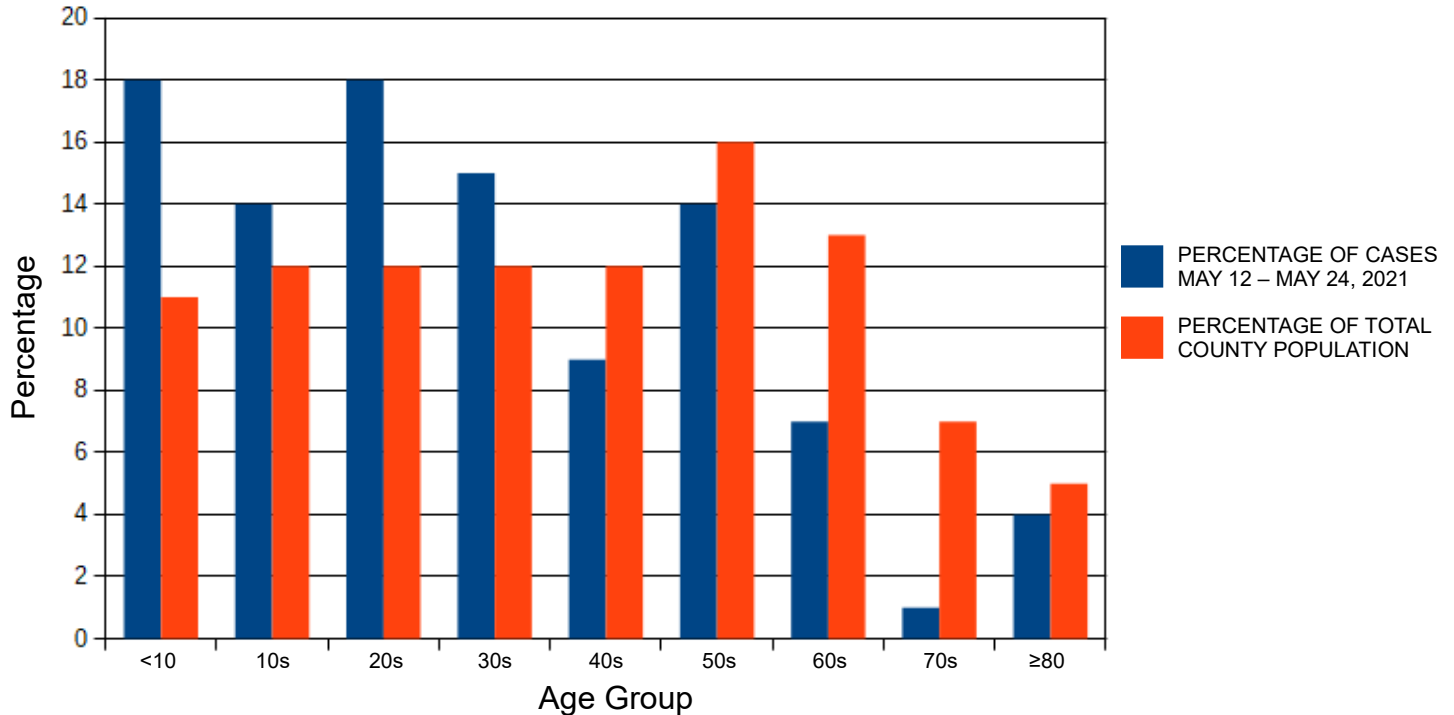
There have been 89 total Cayuga County deaths related to COVID-19
