There have been 6,253 cases of COVID-19 in Cayuga County.

Additional Information:

Attached to today's press release is a graph which illustrates the percentage of COVID-19 cases from May 25 – June 9, 2021 and selected age groups as a percentage of the total county population.

As of today, 33,187 Cayuga County residents have been fully vaccinated. This equates to 43% (77,145 total) of the total population of Cayuga County who are now protected.

With more than half of our community still to be vaccinated, we want to make sure that those who are unvaccinated, including children, continue to protect themselves by wearing a mask when indoors in public settings.

The New York State Department of Health strongly recommends masks in indoor settings where vaccination status of individuals is unknown. Mask requirements by businesses must adhere to all applicable federal and state laws and regulations.

This recommendation will apply across commercial settings, including retail, food services, offices, gyms and fitness centers, amusement and family entertainment, hair salons, barber shops and other personal care services, among other settings.

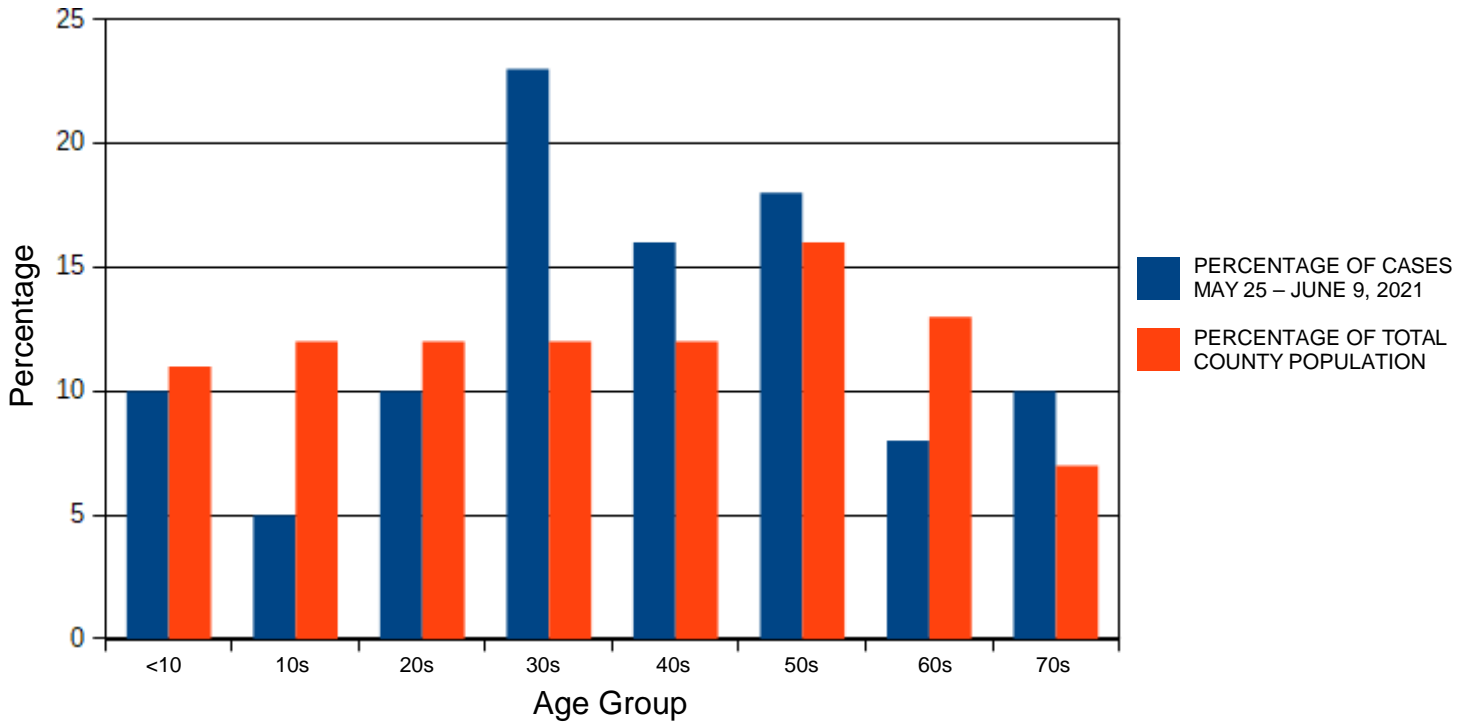
