New Cases

There have been 6,374 cases of COVID-19 in Cayuga County.

Hospitalizations

There are 5 COVID-19 related hospitalizations at Auburn Community Hospital.

Deaths

There have been 91 total Cayuga County deaths related to COVID-19.

A Cayuga County resident – a female in her 80's who was hospitalized and tested positive for COVID-19 – has passed away. Out of respect for the privacy of the deceased and her family, we will not be releasing further information.

Additional Information
