“As the COVID-19 virus remains in our community, I, in collaboration with the Cayuga County Health Department would like to remind our residents that while you are out enjoying the activities that summer months have to offer, it is important to continue to take the proper measures to mitigate the spread of the virus” stated Aileen McNabb-Coleman, chairperson of the Cayuga County Legislature.

As a community, we can help slow the spread of the virus by:

- Wearing a mask when out in public and when around others.
- Staying home if you are ill.
- Staying home if you have been tested for COVID-19 and are awaiting results.

- Getting vaccinated. The vaccines reduce your risk of getting seriously ill even if you do get COVID-19.

The Cayuga County Health Department is holding a walk-in vaccination clinic next week, on Tuesday, August 10, 2021 from 1pm-2pm at Moravia Central School, 68 South Main St., Moravia, NY, 13118. This clinic will be held in the Middle School Gymnasium.

Moderna and Pfizer vaccines will be available at both clinics. Children 12 years of age and older are eligible for the Pfizer vaccine and a parent or guardian must accompany anyone under 18 years of age at this clinic.
