## **Cayuga County COVID-19 Situational Update as of 4:45pm**

### **New Cases:**

Monday, December 27, 2021 – 48 new cases

- 22 unvaccinated, 26 vaccinated

Active Cases in Mandatory Isolation: 413 Mandatory Isolation

### **Confirmed Cases – total since March 18, 2020:**

There have been 11,622 cases of COVID-19 in Cayuga County.

### **Hospitalizations:**

COVID-19 hospitalization reports received today from Crouse Hospital, Upstate University Hospital, St. Joseph's Health, and Auburn Community Hospital: **28 Cayuga County residents** (15 of which are unvaccinated)

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**COVID-19 Vaccination Clinics** are held in the Event Center at the Fingerlakes Mall in the former Spirit Halloween store. Please enter through the back of the mall near the movie theaters. You will not be able to enter through the inside of the mall.

**Wednesday, December 29<sup>th</sup> from 1pm -3pm – Moderna Booster Clinic**

This clinic will offer Moderna booster for those 18 years of age and older.

You must register online for this vaccination clinic: visit [www.cayugacounty.us/health](http://www.cayugacounty.us/health) to schedule an appointment.

**Thursday, December 30<sup>th</sup> from 2pm -4pm – Pfizer Pediatric First and Second Doses**

This clinic will offer Pfizer pediatric first and second doses for those ages 5 through 11 years-old.

You can also register ahead of time online: visit [www.cayugacounty.us/health](http://www.cayugacounty.us/health) to schedule an appointment, but WALK-ins will be accepted at this clinic.

**These clinics are restricted to Cayuga County residents.** Please bring your insurance card and if receiving a second dose or booster, your vaccine card.

The availability of the vaccine is not limited to just the health department. Individuals are encouraged to work with local pharmacies, federally qualified health centers, and healthcare providers to get an appointment.

For anyone without access to the internet, City, Town and Village clerks can assist with online registration as well as the Cayuga Community Health Network by calling 315-252-4212.

**Additional Information:**

COVID-19 is continuing to spread in our community, reflected in our numbers reported in this press release.

If you have tested positive for COVID-19, please remain at home. If you were tested by a health care provider, urgent care center or other testing site, those sites will submit your positive results to the local health department. If you tested positive for COVID-19 on an at-home test kit, you need to submit your at home test result to the Cayuga County Health Department by calling 315-253-1560.

Once results are received you will receive either a call from the Cayuga County Department or someone from the virtual call center out of Albany with a 518 area code. If you do not answer the phone call you will receive a visit from a Cayuga County staff member who will deliver isolation order to you.

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
