Cayuga County officials have been made aware of the challenges residents have faced in getting timely test results from the New York State run testing site in Moravia. This matter has been brought to the attention of the NYS Department of Health to resolve the issues as access to testing is so needed in our community.

Cayuga County has received over 30,000 KN-95 masks provided by New York State. The Cayuga County Office of Emergency Services is distributing these out to town and village offices. Residents are asked to work with their town or village office to obtain these masks.

In addition, New York State made available approximately 3,300 at-home test kits for residents. The test kits are scheduled to be distributed Saturday, January 8, 2022 in Auburn, Cato and Moravia. The Office of Emergency Management Services will be working with Community Action Program (CAP) of Cayuga County to distribute these kits, until supplies run out. Limit one test kit per car, each kit has two tests.

Cars will enter on the dirt road off of Route 38 across from Millard Fillmore Elementary School and follow road into VFW Fairgrounds. Cars will exit onto Adams Street

The collaboration between Cayuga County Office of Emergency Services and CAP will allow for equitable distribution to residents throughout the county who otherwise would not have access to such testing materials.
