Cayuga County COVID-19 Situational Update as of 4:45pm

New Cases:

Tuesday, January 18, 2022 – 354 completed

- 153 unvaccinated, 201 vaccinated

Active Cases in Mandatory Isolation: 598 in Mandatory Isolation

Confirmed Cases – total since March 18, 2020:

There have been 15,428 cases of COVID-19 reported in Cayuga County.

Total hospitalized cases: 25 Cayuga County residents (15 of which are unvaccinated)

COVID-19 hospitalization reports received today from Crouse Hospital, Upstate University Hospital, St. Joseph's Health, and Auburn Community Hospital.
