

Sheriff's Office Monthly Report – September 2021

- Deputy Jerry Field provided a Drone demonstration during the E. John Gavras Center's Inclusion Walk at Casey Park on September 18th. We are proud to support the E. John Gavras Center and this important event.
- On September 28th Sheriff Schenck attended the 2021 Police Officer's Memorial Dedication in Albany as Cayuga County Undersheriff Stephen McLoud's (retired) name was added to the Memorial Wall. Undersheriff McLoud lost his battle with cancer caused by exposure to toxic conditions while assisting in New York City following the 9/11 terror attacks. We will never forget.
- Sheriff's week was recognized September 19 – 25. During this time our members, both sworn and civilian, were recognized for their dedication and service.
- The Centralized Arraignment Part (CAP) Court within our jail was utilized for 64 pre-arraignment detainees in September.
- At the time of this report, we are housing 151 total detained individuals in our jail. Of those detained individuals, 32 are Federal board-ins, 8 NY State Parole Violators that are facing new charges, and 4 Parolees that have been detained for violating their Parole.

- On September 30th, School Resource Officer Roden had the pleasure of visiting three UPK classes as an introduction as to who he was and why he is assigned to Port Byron Schools. Officer Roden read "Officer Buckle and Gloria" to all three classes and was surprised with police hats and badges. We appreciate all Officer Roden does to keep our children and community safe!

- We continue to recognize and recruit area children for our Junior Deputy Program.
