FREE Lead Safe Training for Cayuga County Landlords, Property Managers, & Contractors

The Cayuga County Health Department is hosting a FREE Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Lead Safe Renovation, Repair, and Painting (RRP) training course on Tuesday, September 13, 2022 from 8am – 4pm at the Cayuga County Soil & Water Conservation District located at 7413 County House Rd. in Auburn.

The RRP training will be presented by Lead Safe LLC. Federal law requires workers performing renovation, repair, and painting projects that disrupts lead-based paint in homes, childcare facilities, and schools built before 1978 to be certified and follow specific work practices to prevent lead contamination.

Participants will be provided free supplies promoting lead safe work practices at the end of the training. Funding for the training and supplies are provided by the Cayuga County Childhood Lead Poisoning Prevention Program—a program of the New York State Department of Health.

WHO CAN SIGN-UP FOR THE COURSE?

- All residential rental property managers/owners, landlords, general contractors, maintenance personnel, and trade contractors including: HVAC, painters, plumbers, carpenters, electricians, window replacers, and roofers.
