Novavax COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic

The Cayuga County Health Department will be hosting a first dose Novavax clinic for individuals 12 years of age and older on Friday, October 7, 2022 from 1pm-2pm at our office located at 8 Dill St. in Auburn. This vaccine shall be given to persons having not received any COVID vaccines. Novavax is intended for the 1st and 2nd doses of the primary vaccine series, not a booster.

Appointments will be required and can be made on our website:

Anyone entering the clinic must be wearing a mask. Please bring your insurance card and vaccine card if you have one.

The Novavax vaccine was authorized by the FDA in July 2022. The Novavax vaccine—a traditional protein-based vaccine—offers an additional option for adults who remain unvaccinated against COVID-19.

The availability of the vaccine is not limited to just the health department. Individuals are encouraged to work with local pharmacies, federally qualified health centers, and healthcare providers to get an appointment. Parents looking for the COVID-19 vaccine for children under 5 years of age should contact their child's pediatrician or local pharmacy.
